

ARK BRAZIL WIRE: FUTURE PT GOVERNMENT DOES NOT MEAN RADICAL CHANGES

At a Bloomberg sponsored seminar in Sao Paulo yesterday, Representative Delfim Netto (PPB) and former Central Bank President Gustavo Loyola said that an eventual Labor Party (PT) administration would not bring radical changes in the management of the economy. The opinion of Netto and Loyola was shared by Henrique Meirelles, BankBoston President of Global Banking, and Murillo de Aragao, president of the Brasilia based political consultancy Arko Advice.

Representative Delfim Netto suggested that there are no significant divergences within the Labor Party, which will continue to follow a "light" approach. "Look at Guido Mantega (Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva advisor identified with the "Light PT"). The rest doesn't matter," commented the representative.
